


## American Indians and Alaska Natives Ever Diagnosed with Asthma, by Federal Poverty Level (FPL), California, 2003

- African Americans and American Indian/Alaska Natives of all ages are disproportionately affected by asthma. In the California Health Interview Survey conducted in 2001, adults and children in these two racial groups report significantly higher levels of lifetime asthma diagnosis than all other racial and ethnic groups (page 2).
- American Indian/Alaska Native children have significantly higher asthma prevalence than White or Latino children (page 70).
