
## **Demographic Information for LA County's Latino Population**

## Growth trends indicate that Latinos will become the majority by 2010.



#### Population by Racial/Ethnic Group, Los Angeles County, 2003





## Latino Population by Ethnic Subgroup, Los Angeles County, 2003


