The Department of Parks and Recreation is partnering with other agencies, departments and community-based organizations to provide a wide range of education and nutrition classes, health services provided by mobile health care providers and active or passive recreation programs, all in one setting. With the Healthy Parks Program, local County parks become community service "focal points" in improving health in multifaceted and multicultural ways.

locations are located in high-need areas within our county where the majority of residents are low income, "working poor" and with minimal resources. Low-income, poor nutrition and lack of transportation resulting in lack of access to information and health services make it difficult for these families to address health needs. Special attention is being paid to cultural factors that impact health and to the sensitive development of materials and services that honor the great diversity of experience found in Los Angeles County.
