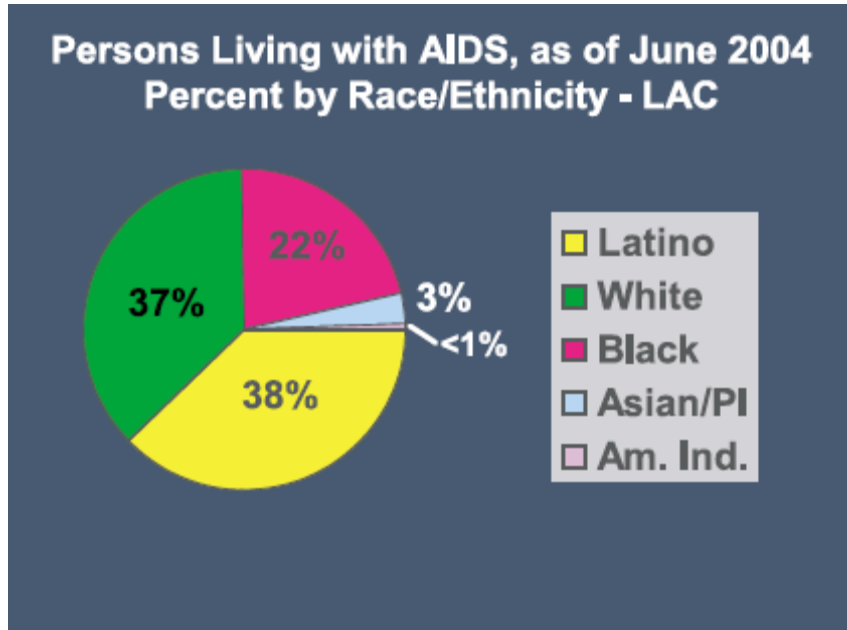
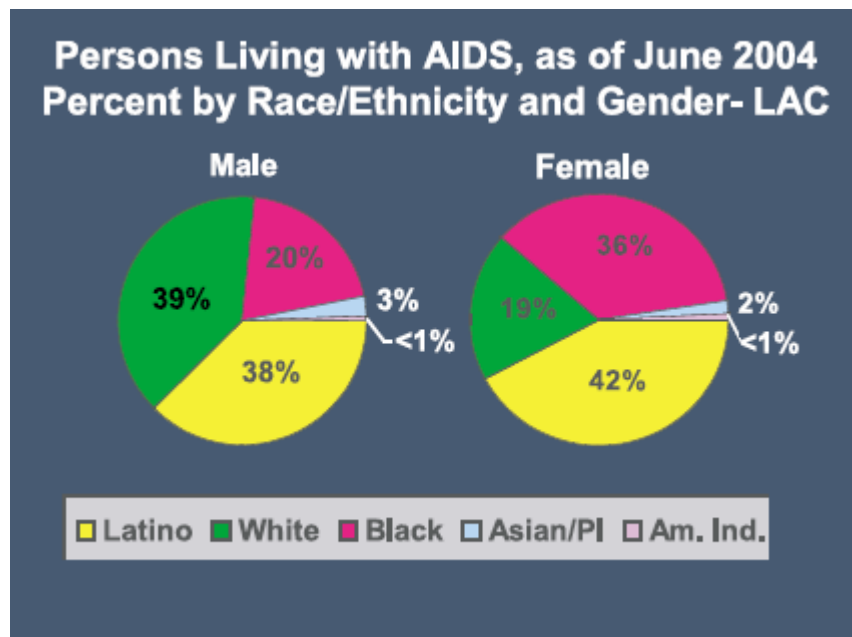

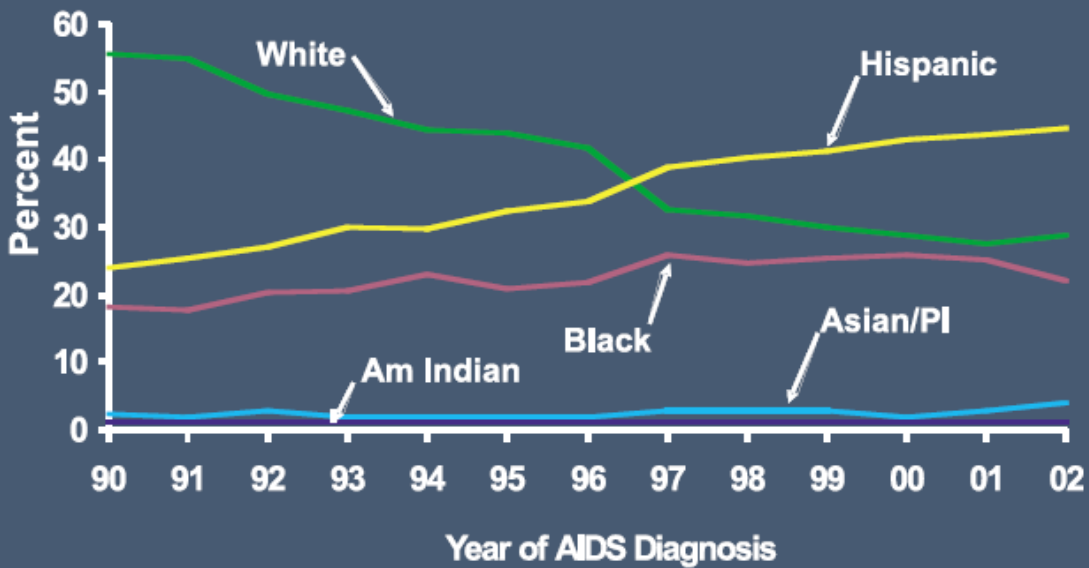

As of 2002, 800 undocumented immigrants were estimated to be living with AIDS in LAC (page 55).
Over two-thirds (68%) of Asians in LAC are foreign-born (page 4).



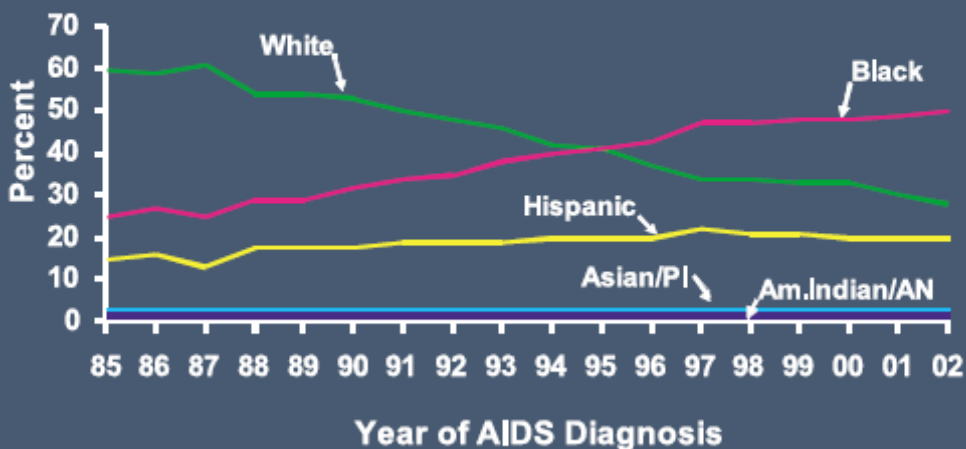
Proportion of AIDS Cases, by Race/Ethnicity and Year of Diagnosis, 1993 - 2002, Los Angeles



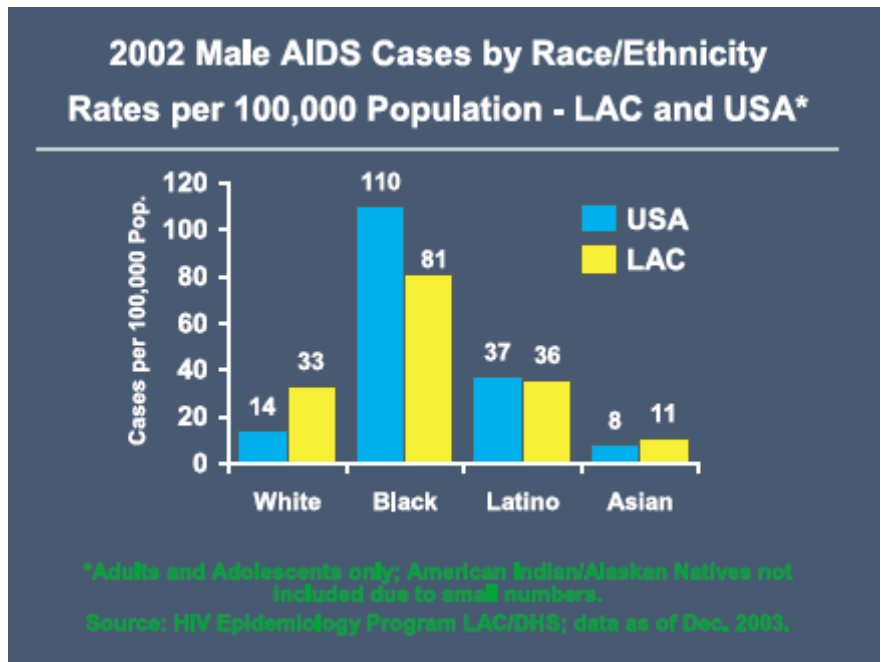

In 1993, Whites comprised 47% of adults and adolescents living with AIDS in LAC, Latinos 30%, Blacks 21%, And **Asian/Pacific Islanders only 2%**. By 2002, however, Latinos comprised the largest number of cases with 44%, followed by Whites at 29%, Blacks at 22%, and **Asian/Pacific Islanders at 4%**. (page 15)
